

## Private Equity Firm Takes Two Floors at 425 Park Ave.

Global private equity firm Hellman & Friedman LLC has signed a lease to relocate its New York offices to L&L Holding Company's 425 Park Avenue, the 47-story office tower that's approaching completion in Midtown Manhattan. Hellman & Friedman LLC will occupy 27,800 square feet on two floors.

As part of a 15-year lease, the firm will relocate from Lever House during the fourth quarter of 2021.
