

Norman Foster's New Office Tower Plans the Fanciest Eatery

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The Lord Norman Foster-designed 425 Park Avenue broke ground today, and at the groundbreaking it was announced that the office tower will include an enormous, two-story, 14,000-square-foot restaurant, also designed by Foster. The restaurateurs behind the project are Daniel Humm and Will Guidara of Eleven Madison Park and the Nomad fame.
